## Presentation

This guide describes connecting the INTRATONE caretaker call panel  ${\ensuremath{\mathbb B}}$  - GSM/PSTN to an INTRATONE central unit  ${\ensuremath{\mathbb B}}.$ 

## Important notes

### **EC standards:**

- The panel complies with the R&TTE Directive 1999/5/EC: electrical safety standard EN 60950 (2001) applied, EMC standard EN 301 489-3 (2002) applied,

#### **Cabling:**

- -The cables connected to the central unit must not be placed in the vicinity of other sources of electrical power (e.g. mains power supply).

#### **Operating warranty**


- The panel is guaranteed to operate within a temperature range of between -20°C and +70°C in which relative humidity does not exceed 70%.

## **End of life product recycling:**








Cabling with a central unit connected to a PSTN line




# Note:
